Tōnui Collab creates reo rua (dual language) STEMM* workshops and wānanga for school groups, after school and school holiday programmes, and professional development workshops for teachers.

*STEMM: Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths and Mātaraunga Māori.

- LEAD the delivery of some of Tōnui Collab's programmes or initiatives.
- CONTRIBUTE to the development of STEMM (science, technology, engineering, maths

 should link to the key education objectives of Tōnui Collab, make connections to the
 NZ Curriculum and Te Marautanga o Aotearoa, and celebrate localised curricula

 should be visible.

- COLLABORATE with team members on the development and implementation of a vision and long term plan
